During this simple act of taking a dog for a walk I met a French Lady of Eighty Plus Years taking her morning constitutional and also came across a young family with a 9 month old baby. You had to be there to see the sparkle in the eyes of the old lady and the excitement in the eyes of the baby.

If such Non-Cost Xplorability that we all take for granted can generate such enjoyment then, just think of what can be achieved by giving greater opportunities to those less fortunate.

Lost Mobility through injury and illness usually results in a painful and emotional rollercoaster ride.

Perhaps only those who have gone through this or, been closely associated with those who have, can understand what this is like.

Some are fortunate to have the fantastic support of Family, Friends, the Military Services etc. but, there are many who do not have this backup.

Those who are older and have experienced “Life” have usually gained some ability to cope with such emotions however, the Young especially may not have, nor, may they have the large support network required to help them.

Chatting with colleagues we feel we would like to address this by expanding our 4wd Adventure Programme to offer opportunities of Ability Adventure to as many as people as possible in association with any interested Sponsor.
